Retinal exam using fundoscopic photography

The CDC Dilated Retinal Exam (DRE) is a HEDIS[®] measure that looks at members age 18 to 75 years old with a diagnosis of type 1 or type 2 diabetes who have completed their dilated eye exam in the measurement year or a negative exam the year prior. The use of the fundoscopic cameras in primary care offices provides the opportunity to close retinal eye exams for members who do not routinely see an eye care professional. Primary care offices that perform a diabetic retinal exam and send the exam to a vision provider to obtain the results of the exam can only be reimbursed at a global level.

Guidelines for provider billing and reimbursement

A PCP group bills the following CPT[®] codes, which *must* be accompanied by a CPT[®] Category II code indicating the exam or fundoscopic image was interpreted by an optometrist or ophthalmologist.

2026F	Eye imaging validated to match diagnosis from seven standard field stereoscopic retinal photos results documented and reviewed; with evidence of retinopathy (DM)
Eye Exam WITHOUT Evidence of Retinopathy	
2023F	Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed; without evidence of retinopathy (DM)
2025F	Seven standard field stereoscopic retinal photos with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed; without evidence of retinopathy (DM)
2033F	Eye imaging validated to match diagnosis from seven standard field stereoscopic retinal photos results documented and reviewed; without evidence of retinopathy (DM)
Eye Exam Negative in Prior Year	
3072F	Low risk for retinopathy (no evidence of retinopathy in the prior year) (DM)

The diabetes ICD-10-CM codes are E08.00 to E13.9.
