## Prior authorization requirement change for HCPCS code K1022

Effective June 1, 2022, prior authorization (PA) requirements will change for HCPCS code K1022. The medical code below will require PA for Anthem Blue Cross members. Federal and state law, as well as state contract language and Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services guidelines, including definitions and specific contract provisions/exclusions, take precedence over these PA rules and must be considered first when determining coverage. Non-compliance with new requirements may result in denied claims.

## What is the impact of this change?

PA requirements will be added to the following:

• **K1022**: Addition to lower extremity prosthesis, endoskeletal, knee disarticulation, above knee, hip disarticulation, positional rotation unit, any type

To request PA, use one of the following methods:

- Web: Log into Availity,\* then select Patient Registration > Authorizations & Referrals. Then select Authorization Request or Auth/Referral Inquiry, as appropriate.
