Agreement Between Supervising Physician and Non-Physician Medical Provider Regarding Medical Assistant Supervision

This agreement states that medical assistants are allowed to perform certain procedures and technical support services under the supervision of mid-Level providers when the physician is not present.

Per the Medical Board of California medical assistant description: medical assistants are unlicensed individuals who administer medication only by intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections and perform skin tests and additional technical supportive services under the supervision of a licensed physician and surgeon, podiatrist, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or nurse midwife in a medical setting. The supervising physician must be on the premises in order for the medical assistant to perform supportive tasks and services. Under the provisions of Business and Professions Code Section 2069 (a)(2), the supervision of a medical assistant may be delegated to a mid-level practitioner when the supervising physician is not on site.
