

EnrollSafe/EFT enrollment portal

In November 1, 2021, EnrollSafe* replaced CAQH Enrollhub as the electronic funds transfer (EFT) enrollment portal for providers. Sign up in the EnrollSafe Enrollment Hub at https://enrollsafe.payeehub.org.



Once you have completed registration, you will be directed through the EnrollSafe secure portal to the enrollment page, where you will provide the information required

to receive direct payment deposits. If you are already enrolled in EFT through CAQH Enrollhub, no action is needed unless you are making changes. Your EFT enrollment information will not change as a result of the new enrollment hub.

Electronic remittance advice (ERA) makes reconciling your EFT payment easy and paper-free.

Using the digital ERA is the best way to reconcile your deposits securely and safely. You will be issued a trace number with your EFT deposit that matches up with your ERA in Availity Essentials.

You can view or download a copy of the *Remittance Advice* under Payer Spaces > Applications > Remittance Inquiry tool.

ERAs are made available through Availity or through your clearinghouse or billing service.
