Re: 340B Reconciliation of Claims

The Kentucky Department for Medicaid Services (DMS) is implementing a new process to identify and reconcile 340B claims. DMS requests that you assist by disseminating this information to the applicable providers/facilities within your network. Covered entities (and their respective contract pharmacies) who wish to participate in the 340B program should read and complete the attached "Participation Form" by COB **Tuesday, March 15th, 2022** for inclusion of Q1 2022 claims. For covered entities and their contract pharmacies who choose not to participate in the 340B program, please note, you do NOT need to submit a "non-participation agreement" to DMS. Non-participation is assumed if a "participation" agreement is not submitted to DMS. Please review all four documents **completely** and note that DMS will respond to any questions regarding these documents as soon as possible. DMS will post updates to the FAQ document regularly on the DMS Pharmacy Policy Branch Website as well as the MedImpact website (under Provider Portal documents).
