- **Find the right support:** Virginia Medicaid mental health services offer many community-based treatment options including crisis services, family supports services, applied behavioral analysis (ABA) services, substance use disorder, and intensive in-home supports.
- **Connect with care:** Care coordination through HealthKeepers, Inc. can assist in linking your pediatric members with services including:
  - Therapeutic day treatment (TDT).
  - Intensive in-home services (IIH).
  - Multisystemic therapy (MST).
  - Functional family therapy (FFT).
  - Applied behavior analysis (ABA).
  - Mental health partial hospitalization program (PHP).
  - Mental health intensive outpatient program (IOP).
  - Mental health case management.
  - Mobile crisis response.
  - Community stabilization.
  - 23-Hour crisis stabilization.
  - Residential crisis stabilization.
